

## **Free School Meal Eligibility and Pupil Premium**

Your completion of this form enables us to check for Free School Meal Eligibility and also whether the Academy can claim additional money (Pupil Premium) from the Government.

Pupil Premium is the additional funding given to schools for pupils who have been registered as being entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) at any point in the last 6 years. Schools receive this funding to support their eligible pupils and narrow the attainment gap between them and their peers. Further information about how the Academy spends these monies can be found on the Academy website.

Free School Meals can be provided to Junior and Secondary School Children if they meet the eligibility criteria. All infant school children are automatically eligible for Free School Meals from September 2014.

## **Eligibility Criteria for Free School Meals**

Parents do not have to pay for school lunches if they receive any of the following:

Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance / Employment and Support Allowance	
Income Support (IS)	
Income based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)	
Income related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)	
Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999	
The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit	
Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190	
N.B. If you receive WORKING TAX CREDIT you do not qualify even if you receive child tax credit and your income is below £16,190	
Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit	
Universal Credit	

Children who receive any of the qualifying benefits listed above in their own right are also eligible to receive free school meals.
