## News from the Art Department

Year 9 are studying natural forms and coastal towns this academic year. The students are looking at a variety of artists including Yayoi Kusama, Georgia O’Keeffe and Turner. Students are focusing primarily on Yayoi Kusama, a Japanese contemporary artist working in sculpture and installation. She is also active in painting, performance, film, fashion, poetry, fiction and other arts. The students have been influenced by Kusama’s patterns, working their own designs onto fabric tote bags using batik wax.

Students are making artisan, ethical handmade goods such as tote bags and ceramics which will be sold at the Craft Market events at Park Academy West London in March and also at Kings Road Chelsea. In this project students will be developing entrepreneurship skills including finance- costing, marketing and product innovation skills. The money raised from this event will be used to finance their school trip to St. Ives visiting The Tate Gallery, Barbara Hepworth, Leach Pottery plus attending painting workshops. This is a major event for our students because not only they are designing, making but understanding the burgeoning craft movement which brings £3.4bn to the UK economy.
