Definition: a point of view.


How to use in today's lesson: Consider how to establish a strong narrative **perspective** within your writing.



Slow writing enables you to think about what you are including in your writing rather than getting 'carried away' by your creative idea.



You are assessed on the quality of writing. Therefore, by taking a more considered approach, you are able to establish a powerful tone that is easier to sustain throughout a piece of writing.



Quality > Quantity

What is slow writing?

Our slow writing technique:

01

Your first sentence must start with a present participle (that's a verb ending in 'ing')

02

Your second sentence must contain only three words.

03

Your third sentence must contain a semi-colon

04

Your fourth sentence must be a rhetorical question

05

Your fifth sentence will start with an adverb

06

Your sixth sentence will contain a simile
