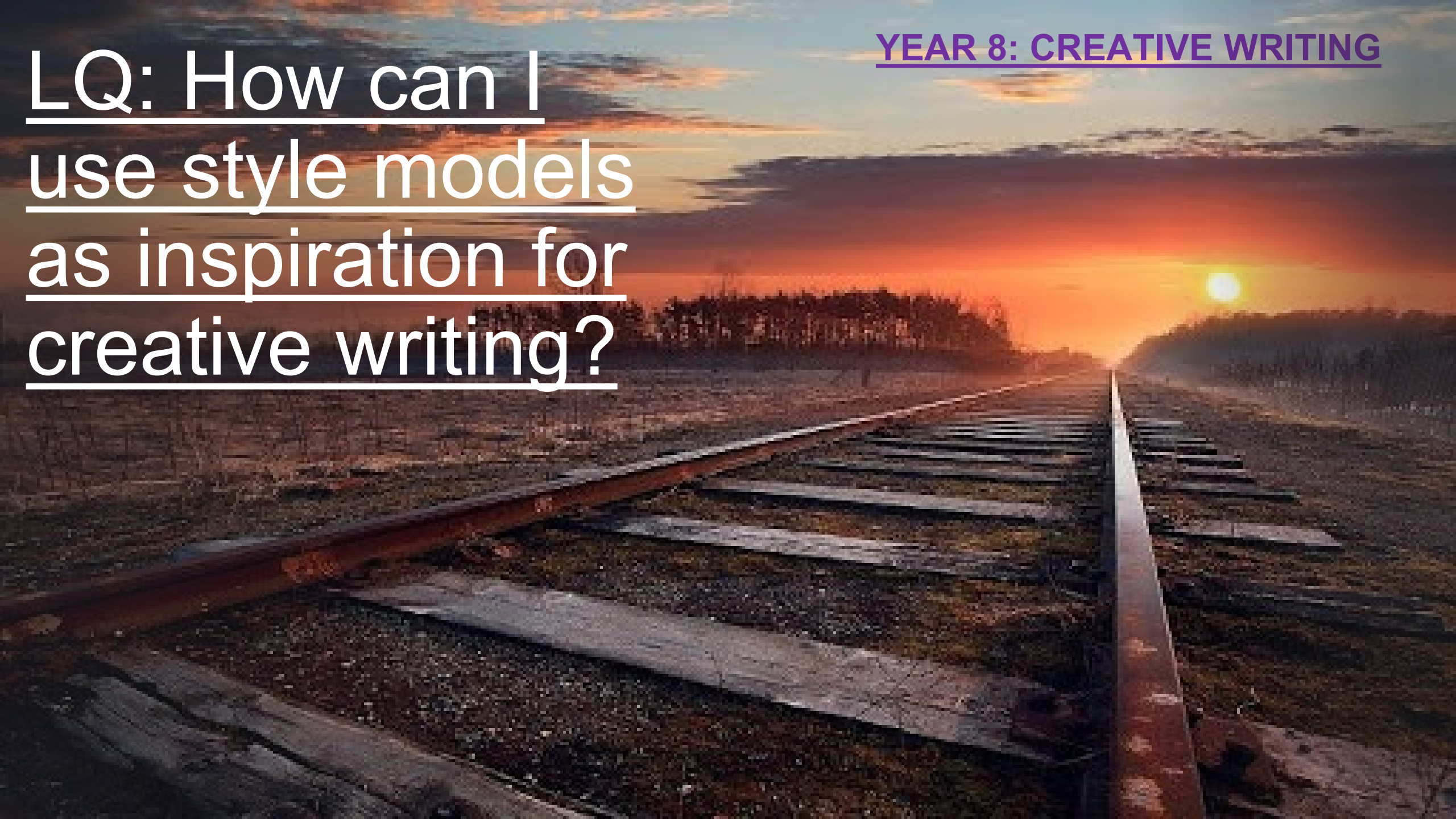

By actively reading books you are much more likely to be successful at creative writing as you are able to consider what makes you interested in a story, in turn understanding the craftsmanship of a successful piece of writing.



Read through the opening of the Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy

As you read:

What information do we learn about Arthur Dent?

What genre of book is this - how can we tell?

What do we learn about the narrative in the story?



Having read the chapter:

What linguistic devices has the writer used to create a humorous tone in the story?

How is the extract structured for effect?

What do you like/dislike about the story?

Does it interest you as a reader?
Why/Why not?
