1. Band members

What is an ensemble?

2. Repertoire

What genre/s of music do the band specialise in? e.g. Rock, RnB

Do they have a big repertoire i.e. Do they explore different sounds?

What are the band's most popular singles

3. Organisation

Why is it important for this band to be organised? E.g. book and be on time for band rehearsals, bring all equipment to rehearsals etc..

4. Communication e.g. musical interaction, interaction with audience

What techniques do this band use to communicate musically with each other? E.g. count ins etc... (include video link of rehearsal/performance)

How does this band communicate with the audience? E.g. waving hands etc...(include video link of live performance)

5. Listening Skills

Why is it important that each member of the band can be when they are playing together?

6. Co-orporation

Why is it important that each band member makes a contribution, helps each other, offers up ideas during rehearsals?

7. Reheasals

Why are rehearsals important?
