Re: Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day

Friday 9th December, we are inviting students and staff to participate in Christmas Jumper Day to raise money for Save the Children. We know times are tough, so please remember that donations are voluntary (it's taking part that counts!), and any amount you can spare, 20p, 50p, £1, will be greatly appreciated. Also, this year, whatever anyone donates will make double the difference because the UK government is going to match all donations to Christmas Jumper Day. This year, all the money raised will go towards helping 200,000 mums and babies in Kenya get the food and medicine they need, as every year over 74,000 children die before the age of five.

Remember, there's no need to buy a new jumper as we would like to be as ethical as possible. You could upcycle an old jumper, get crafty and make your own, or head to a local charity shop to buy a pre-loved one. Or simply re-wear the one you wore last year. If you want to get creative and decorate a jumper, the Christmas Jumper Day website contains lots of fun craft ideas.

We do need to remind you that the Christmas jumper will only replace the school jumper, so the rest of the uniform remains the same, including the blazer which must be worn as normal. The only exception to this is the shirt and tie which does not need to be worn as long as the student does not take their jumper off.

All donations will be collected by members of our Student Leadership Team during morning registration. In addition, the Sixth Form will also be holding a small cake sale during the morning break to raise further funds for Save the Children.

We would appreciate your support to make Support the Children's Christmas Jumper Day a success. Together, we can make the world better with a sweater.
