Post 16

In the sixth form, a varied curriculum is offered. All students in Year 12 will follow three A levels or equivalent plus the Aspirations Employability Diploma (AED), which is unique to the Aspirations Academies Trust. This is a programme designed to help post 16 students prepare for employment and success in a fast changing world. Study of the AED enables students' continuous reflection with regard to career planning. It sets a framework formed around a series of driving research questions, and allows students to develop a range of professional skills to maximise their learning potential.
