Re: Wear it Green Day 2023

According to the Office for National Statistics (2020), nearly one-third of 16-24 year olds in the UK (31%) reported some evidence of depression or anxiety in 2017 to 2018. This is up from the previous year (26%). In addition to this, it is widely acknowledged that the pandemic had a devastating impact on the mental health of young people, with many still suffering years later.

From Monday 15th May, the Mental Health Foundation are holding their annual Mental Health Awareness Week to raise the profile of mental health in young people, tackle stigma and work together to develop a society that prevents mental health problems from developing and protects everyone's mental health.
